### Recognitions and Identity

(Order from International Division.)

*International Scouting Flag.* White World Crest on 3-by-5-foot purple flag for indoor and outdoor use. No. ID-173

*Small International Flag.* On stand for desktop display. No. ID-162

*Jamboree-on-the-Air Patch.* BSA patch for participants in annual JOTA. Worn as temporary patch on right pocket. No. ID-183

*Direct Service Shoulder Patch.* Shoulder patch worn only by Direct Service members on the left shoulder seam. The council serves about 4,000 BSA members who live in other nations. No. ID-184

*Gamenowinink Lodge 555 OA Flap.* Order of the Arrow lodge emblem for Direct Service. May be worn by lodge members only on right pocket flap. No. ID-185

*International Youth Exchange Emblem.* Embroidered 3-inch emblem. Worn by Boy Scouts, Varsity Scouts, Explorers, and Scouters who complete an international exchange program as defined by the International Division. This is a temporary emblem worn centered on the right pocket of the uniform shirt. No. ID-214

(Order through your local council.)

*International Representative.* Embroidered 3-inch badge of office for an adult Scouter serving as council international representative. Worn on left sleeve of uniform. No. 00141

*World Crest.* Embroidered 1½-inch purple emblem. Worn permanently by Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, Varsity Scouts, Explorers, and Scouters to symbolize their membership in the world Scouting movement. The emblem is worn centered horizontally over the left pocket and vertically between the left shoulder seam and the top of the pocket. No. 00143

*International Activity Patch.* Embroidered 3-inch emblem. Worn by Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, Varsity Scouts, Explorers, and Scouters who participate in an international activity or program as defined by a local council. This is a temporary emblem worn centered on the right pocket of the uniform shirt. No. 00144

*International Jacket Patch.* Embroidered 5-inch emblem. Worn by Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, Varsity Scouts, Explorers, and Scouters who participate in an international activity or program as defined by a local council. The emblem is worn centered on the back of any official uniform jacket. No. 00145

*International Neckerchief.* Dark blue with a red and white striped border. This neckerchief has the international activity patch hot-pressed on the point for wear by members who participate in an international activity or program as defined by a local council. No. 00746

*Cub Scout World Conservation Award.* Giant panda on Scout trefoil. Two-inch embroidered emblem worn as temporary patch on right pocket. Requirements for Cub Scouts are in Cub Scout Leader Book. No. 00139

*Boy Scout World Conservation Award.* Giant panda on Scout trefoil. Two-inch embroidered emblem worn as temporary patch on right pocket. Requirements are in the Boy Scout Handbook. No. 00140
